#### Best nectar plants for adult butterflies - a selection

Early season: Aubretia, Bluebell, Clover, Cuckooflower, Daisy, Dandelion, Forget-me-not, Honesty, Pansy, Primrose, Sweet Rocket and Wallflower

Late summer/autumn: Buddleia, French Marigold, Hemp Agrimony, Ice Plant (sedum spectabile), Ivy, Knapweed, Lavender, Marjoram (Origano), Michaelmas Daisy, Mint, Red Valerian, Scabious (Field and Devil's Bit), Thyme and Verbena Bonariensis
